Who can apply (eligibility):

How to apply:

- The Application should be countersigned and duly certified by the Head of the Institution/Controlling authority.
- Participants should enclose self-attested copies of Aadhaar Card along with the application.

Maximum numbers of Trainees: Thirty (30)

Procedure of Selection: Priority may be given to:

- Trainee who has attended less number of CME. • Trainee based on seniority in service.
