1. The tenders should be submitted in "TWO BID SYSTEM". The FIRST ENVELOPE should contain Technical bid, DD/Banker's cheque, Tender Fee Coupon/DD, Registration Certificate copy from DGS & D or trade license or any other State Govt., copies of Supply Orders and successful execution of the Contract for past performance, Copy of PAN No., Audited Balance Sheets, Income Tax return, Sale Tax registration or copy of Constitution of firm / company, The SECOND ENVELOPE should contain the prescribed financial bid form duly filled in and signed along with the quoted prices, The bidder should put these two sealed envelopes in a bigger envelope and this outer cover should be wax sealed.
2. Tenderer is advised to clearly tick either YES or NO against the Technical specification of Fully Automated Clinical Chemistry Analyser.
3. The supply of instrument concluded as a result of this Tender Inquiry shall be governed by the 'Terms & Conditions' and other relevant instruction as contained in this Tender Document.
4. The prices/rates quoted should be indicated in words as well as figures for the instrument.
5. Tenderers are requested to quote their prices on a firm & fixed basis only for the complete supply of equipments. Tender of the firms received with prices quoted on variable basis shall be rejected straight – way.
6. Quotations qualified by such vague and indefinite expressions such as "subject to prior confirmation", "subject to immediate acceptance" etc will be treated as vague offers and rejected accordingly.
7. Tenderers are requested to enclose a copy of their valid certificate of PAN No., TAN No, and Service Tax No. with Technical bid.
8. Tenders received without Tender Fee Coupon, EMD amount by way of DD or Pay Order/ Banker's Cheque in the name of Assistant Director, RRI AYURVEDA, BANTALAB, JAMMU will not be considered at all.
9. Tenderers may note that if the date of tender receiving/opening given in this Tender Document is declared to be a gazetted holiday, In such an event the closing hours for receipt of tenders in ARRI and opening of tender respectively will stand automatically extended upto 1500 hours of the next working day in the Government offices.
10. Late/delayed tenders received in ARRI due to any reason what so ever will not be accepted under any circumstances.
11. Tendering firms are at liberty to be present or authorize a representative to be present at the opening of the tender. 13. The Technical bid will be opened first and those agency /firm whose quotation qualify in Technical bid shall only be considered for opening of financial bid.
14. The tenderer have no claim for acceptance of any deviations in Technical specifications and conditions.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. EMD will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders within 30 days after award of the supply order to successful bidders
2. ARRI reserves the right to approve the suppliers and place orders on any such items that may be the most economical to it or suitable to its requirements.
3. For judicial adjudication, the disputes, if any, arising out of the Contract/ supply orders jurisdiction of the Court will be in Jammu only.
4. Intending Tenderers will have to furnish a copy of their PAN No., TIN No. and Sale Tax Registration Number (proof to be attached).
5. Authorized Signatory / Signing of Tender: Individual signing the tender or other documents connected with contract must specify the capacity in which the tender documents are signed as:
 - a) A 'sole proprietor' of the concern or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor;
 - b) A partner of the firm, if it be a partnership firm, in which case he must have authority to execute contracts on behalf of the firm and to refer to arbitration disputes concerning the business of the partnerships either by virtue of the partnership agreement or by a power of attorney duly executed by the partners of the firm.

NOTES:

- In case of partnership firms, a copy of the partnership agreement, or general power of attorney duly attested by a Notary Public, should be furnished on stamped paper duly sworn or affirmed by all the partner admitting execution of the partnership agreement or the general power of attorney. The attested copy of the certificate of registration of firm should also be enclosed along with the tender.
 - In case of partnership firms, where no authority to refer disputes concerning the business of partnership firm has been conferred on any partner , the tender and all other related documents must be signed by all partners of the firm.

 7. The tendering firms will have to give a declaration to the effect that they have not been Black listed or their business dealings with the Government bodies have not been banned.
 8. The prices charged for the stores supplied under the Contract by the supplier shall in no event exceed the lowest price at which the Contractors sells the Stores or offer to sell stores of identical description to any person(s)/organization(s) including the ARRI or any Corporation of a State Government or any statutory undertaking of the Central or a State Government, as the case may be, during the period till performances of all Supply Orders is completed. If at any time during the said period , the Contractor reduces the Sale price , sells or offers to sell such stores to any person(s) /organization (s) including the Purchase or any

Statutory Undertaking of the State Government as the case may be , at a price lower than the price chargeable under this Contract , he shall forthwith notify such reduction or Sale or offer of Sale to the ARRI and the price payable under the Contract for the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale or offer of sale corresponding reduced.

The supplier shall furnish the following certificate to the Paying Authority along with each bill for payment for supplies made against the supply order "I/We certify that there has been no reduction in sale price of the stores of Description identical to the Stores supplied to ARRI under the contract herein and such Stores have not been offered /sold by me /us to any person(s) /organization(s) as the case may be up to date of the bill /the date of completion of supplies against this contract at a price lower than the price charged toARRI."

12. Terms of Delivery: As per terms & conditions of Tender form

13. Delivery Period: Within 30 days of the placement of confirmed supply order on the firm or as stipulated in the supply order.

14. Payments Terms: 100% payment shall be released within 15 days of satisfactory installation of the goods / articles ordered. Advance payment will not be made under any circumstances.

15. Dispatch Instructions Stores are required to be delivered at the ARRI,BANTALAB,JAMMU

16. Purchaser will not pay any amount separately for transit insurance till the entire stores contracted for, arrive in good condition at the destination. The supplier will be responsible for demo and installation of the instrument in the premises of ARRI.

17. Guarantee/Warranty:

The supplier shall guarantee that the stores, articles sold/supplied to the purchaser under this contract shall be of the best quality and workmanship and new in all respects and shall be strictly in accordance with the specification and particulars contained/mentioned in the Tender enquiry. The supplier shall guarantee that the said goods/stores articles would continue to conform to the description and quality aforesaid for a period of twelve months, if during the aforesaid period of 12 months the said stores/goods/articles be discovered not to conform to the description and quality aforesaid or not giving satisfactory performance or have deteriorated, the decision of the purchaser in that behalf shall be final and binding on the supplier and the purchaser shall be entitled to call upon the supplier to rectify the goods /stores/articles or such portion thereof as is found to be defective by the purchaser within a reasonable period or such specified period as may be allowed by the purchaser in his discretion on/an application made thereof by the supplier and in such an event, the above mentioned warranty period shall apply to the goods/stores/articles rectified from the date of rectification thereof. In case of failure of the supplier to rectify or replace the goods etc., within specified time, the purchaser shall be entitled to recover the cost with all expense from the supplier for such defective stores.

18. Tenderer is advised to mention the terms/conditions for at least three year warranty & AMC thereafter of the instrument.

19. All firms are required to submit the following information along with their quotation failing which their tender will be rejected:

- a) Name and full address of their Banker with the Account Number.
- b) List of organization /offices to whom the bidding firm has made supply for the last 3 years.
- c) Performance statement for the last three year in respect of Scientific Instrument supplied must be submitted in the format enclosed at Annexure-"1" to this tender document.
- d) Financial Status of the firm -enclosed tax returns for 2011-2012, 2012-2013&2013-2014.

20. Tenderer who are registered with DGS&D/NSIC for a particular item should submit the photocopy of Registration Certificate with all amendments up to date.
21. Duties & Taxes
Sales Tax: Tenderer should indicate whether the prices quoted are exclusive or inclusive of sales tax. They should indicate the rate(s) of VAT/Local Sales Tax (as may be applicable) and Central Sales Tax with & without Form-"C". In case, they are exempted from payment of sales tax, a copy of the Exemption Certificate issued by the appropriate authority may be furnished.
NOTE: It is informed that this Institute is exempted for purpose of availing Custom Duty and Central Excise Duty (Certificate Attached).
22. TENDERERS ARE REQUESTED TO QUOTE THEIR RATES ON F.O.R DESTINATION BASIS (Free delivery to the consignee's premises)
23. The decision of the ARRI shall be final as to the quality of the stores and shall be binding upon the tenderer and in case any of the articles supplied not being found as per specification shall be liable to be rejected

OR

24. Replaced and any expenses or losses caused to the suppliers shall be borne by the supplier. It will be the responsibility of the supplier to ensure that articles supplied are of the best quality and free from all defects.
25. Item-wise price should be quoted; In case of bundled price the offer shall be summarily rejected.
26. Liquidated Damages: In case the firm does not complete the supply within delivery period, action will be taken against the firm to recover from the contractor as agreed liquidated damages including administrative expenses by way of penalty a sum equivalent to 2% per week of the price of stores which the contractor has failed to deliver /install within the period fixed for delivery of such stores. Where delivery thereof is accepted after expiry of the aforesaid period, the total damages so claimed shall not exceed 10% of the total price of stores required.

Terms and conditions for registration of public funded research institutions, etc., other than a hospital for the purposes of availing customs/central excise duty exemption in terms of Govt. notifications no.51/96-customs dt.23.7.1996 and no.10/97-central excise dt.1.3.1997 as amended from time to time.

01. The institution should acknowledge receipt of the registration letter by stating that they will abide by the terms and conditions of registration.
02. The registration would be valid for the period specified in the registration letter**. Request for renewal of registration shall be made in the prescribed proforma, at least 3 months before the expiry of the valid registration. Applications received late may not be considered.
*** However, certificate of registration is not valid for activities falling within the definition of 'hospital' as per notification no. 51/96-Customs dated 23.07.1996 and No. 10/97-Central Excise dated 01.03.1997 issued by the Department of Revenue. The institutions are cautioned to go through the notifications before availing duty exemptions under these notifications.*
03. Brief summary of the R&D activities, status of on-going projects and achievements of the institution shall be submitted to the DSIR at the end of 5(five) years, in case of institution where validity of registration is 10(ten) years. This should include details related to papers published, patents obtained and processes developed, new products introduced, awards & prizes received and copy of the latest Annual Report.
03. The institution should have a broad based research advisory committee (RAC), which should meet at regular intervals for approving, guiding and monitoring the ongoing and future research projects.
04. The institution should have separate budget for research. The institution should utilise the duty exemption facility as per the above-mentioned notifications, for research purposes only. Non-research requirement such as the one for service activities, teaching, training, patient care, etc. should not be procured availing the facility.
05. The institutions should introduce a chapter in its Annual Report dealing with the research & development work. This could contain the on-going research projects, achievements during the year, publications, patents if any, etc. The R&D income & expenditure should be separately shown in an annexure/schedule in the statement of accounts in the Annual Report.
06. The registration will entitle the institutions to avail customs/excise duty exemption on purchase of equipment, instruments, spares thereof, consumables etc. used for research & development subject to relevant Government policies in force from time to time. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS OF FULLY AUTOMATED CLINICAL CHEMISTRY ANALYZER

1. It should be Automated, Discrete, Bench Top Random Access Clinical chemistry Analyzer capable of performing biochemistry and immune-turbidimetry assays.
2. The throughput should be at least 150-200 tests/hr photometric tests and 300-300 tests/hr with ISE (optional).
3. It should have minimum 35-40 on line chemistries.
4. It should not have any limit on number of programmable Chemistries, Profiles and Calculation Item.
5. It should accept Linear, Non-Linear, Multi Point Calibration.
6. Sample disk should accept minimum 28 To 35 samples at a time. All the positions on the sample disk should accept STAT samples, blanks, controls, standards and ISE solutions.
7. It should accept primary tubes and sample cups for keeping samples.
8. The sample pipetting should be between 2 – 60 μ l.
9. The reagent tray should be cooled and should accept more than 45 reagent bottles. It should accept both 20 ml, 50 ml bottles and 5 ml adapters.
10. Display of Reaction Cuvette temperature and Reagent Tray temperature should be available on Screen.
11. Display of tank pressure should be available.
12. Biohazard waste should be collected in a separate container.
13. System should be capable of performing 2 Reagent Chemistries.
14. It should have barcode reader for both reagents and samples (Optional).
15. Reagent pipetting should be between 50 – 300 μ l in steps of 1 μ l.
16. The reaction cuvettes should be permanent. Single cuvette should be replaceable.
17. On line Reaction Graph should be displayed on the screen and all the reaction graphs should be stored in the memory.

18. The minimum reaction volume should be less than 250 μl .
19. It should have on board laundry for washing of the cuvettes.
20. Photometer should consist of 8 stationary filters. 340, 405, 505, 546, 578, 600, 660 and 700 nm. It should be capable of doing Monochromatic and Bichromatic measurements.
21. Light source should be Halogen Lamp.
22. Absorbance range should be 0.0 – 2.5 Abs.
23. It should have extensive Q. C. program. Should show daily and monthly Levy Jennings Chart.
24. It should have facility of auto re-run, auto dilution.
25. Probe should have Vertical obstruction Detection.
