- Under Tribal Health Care Research Programme, the THCRP team made 48 surveys to cover 2569 nos. of population of tribal villages at Ghatagaon Block, Dist. Keonjhar, Odisha. The team provided medical consultation with free medicines to 1269 nos. of patients and collected 03 numbers of Folklore claims for documentation.
- During the quarter, 60 surveys were conducted under the outreach activity Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCSP) in the selected areas in Bhubaneswar and 2591 numbers of population covered. 2522 patients were provided medical consultation with free medicines and two Folklore claims collected.
