Regional Ayurveda Research Institute (RARI) is a premier Institute for research on medicinal plants of North-West Himalayan region of India. The total land of the premises is 0.602 hectare and situated in between 29°36.877'N and 79°-24.277'E at an elevation of 5506 feet. The Institute has its own excellent building with the total built-up area of 2560.17 Sq. meter. Institute has two medicinal plant gardens at Ranikhet & Chamba and a Musk Deer Research Centre at Mehruri, Bageshwar.

Achievements at a Glance since Inception

- The Institute has been certified with NABH Ayush Entry Level Centre.
- Explored 42 forest divisions covering approximataly 54,000 sq. km. area that accounts about 25% of Western Himalaya from Tarai-Bhabar belt to alpine zones.
- The institute has a collection of more than sixty thousands herbarium specimens representing different families, genera and species of Angiosperms, Gymnosperms and Pteridophytes.
- Identified many Shilajeet bearing spots in Kumaon and Garhwal regions of Himalya.
- New records made on occurrence of Indian Ginseng (Panax pseudoginseng Wall and an Orchid (Diplomeris hirsuta Lindl) from Western Himalaya.
- Plants like Wallichia densiflora Mart and Phrynium placentarium (Lour) Merr considered diminished for about a century have been noticed and collected.
- Saffron has been successfully cultivated in non habitat area of Ranikhet and monograph was published.
- More than 550 medicinal folk claim has been collected.
- Herbal wealth of Uttarakhand has been compiled in two volumes and published.
- Monograph on Saffron has been published.
