The Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS) and its 30 units across the country organised month-long celebration for the 8th Ayurveda Day, focusing on the theme "Ayurveda for One Health" and the tagline "Ayurveda for Everyone on Every Day." The celebration, held from October 10th to November 10th, 2023, emphasised the interconnectedness between humans, animals, plants, and the environment. On November 9th, 2023, CCRAS hosted a conference on 'Ayurveda for One Health,' followed by the main event of the 8th Ayurveda Day on November 10th, 2023, at the Indradhanush Auditorium in Panchkula, Haryana, in honour of Dhanvantari Divas.

The event was graced by esteemed dignitaries, including Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, Cabinet Minister Ministry of Ayush & Ministry of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways; Dr Munjpara Mahendrabhai Kalubhai, Union Minister of State for Ayush, and WCD; Hon'ble Vidhan Sabha Speaker of Haryana, Sh.
