Aconite available in Indian markets is a mixture of Aconitum ferox, A. lycoctonum, A. napellus and A. palmatum. On treatment with cow's urine or cow's milk, it has been said to lose much of its toxicity, but to still retain the antipyretic, analgesic and anti-inflammatory properties of the crude drug.
