

Medicinal Folk lore of Orissa-II Gastrointestinal Disorders

The present communication, second of the series, deals with 72 plants used for the treatment of various gastro-intestinal disorders by the village folk of Orissa. The information presented in the paper was recorded during the years 1976 to 1983, in course of medico-ethnobotanical exploration of the various localities of the State. After consultation of the available important literature, the authors noted that out of 72 taxa enumerated here 45 are such of which (plant|plant part) are not indicated earlier for these ailments.
