Contribution to the Botanical Identity of *Kurasani* omam in South Indian Crude Drug Trade

Kurasani omam or Paraseeka yavani or Kurasani Ajwain is well known to the Siddha, Ayurveda and Unani practitioners. According to the available literature, the drug is derived from Hyoscyamus niger Linn. of the family Solanaceae.

However the market samples from peninsular India did not conform to the above identification. This material has been identified to be a species of the Capparaceae.

The morphology of the drug and the steps leading to its botanical identification are dealt with.
