

Cultivation/Extraction of Gum-oleo resin of *Commiphora wightii* (Arn.) Bhand at Guggulu Herbal Farm Mangliawas-Problems and Prospects

The Council has undertaken an extensive cultivation of Commiphora wightii (Arn.) Bhand (Guggulu) in 142 acre of land at Mangliawas in District, Ajmer of Rajasthan. So far 25,000 Guggulu plants are thriving well in the farm along with different other medicinal plant species.

The present paper highlights the problems being faced in the propagation of Guggulu and different methods of Tapping/Extraction of Gum-oleo-resin along with the possible and feasible measures to be adopted for solving these problems.
