During recent years the demand for illugs has been immensely increased fesulting in the introduction of various delignant and substitute drugs, therefore, the cultivation of genuine drugs is necessary to stop this practise. It is an easily oullivable drug and trials for its propagation in the sandy soil of Bundelkhand have been undertaken.
