Botanical Source of Gajapippali in Kerala

In Ayurvedic Nighantus four types of Pippalis are mentioned. They are Pippali, Gajapippali, Souhali and Vanapippali. Gajapippali is a contraversial drug. Scindapsus officinalis and Piper chaba are considered as the source plants of Gajapippali. In Kerala market another drug from a non-allied Botanical source was found traded and used by the Vaidyas and Pharmacies. The botanical identification of this drug and a discussion on Gajapippali are dealt in this paper.
