

## Cultivation of Medicinal Plants along Sea-coasts in Maharashtra

*The long stretches of barren sea-coasts in Maharashtra offer promising natural habitats for growing indigenous medicinal plants. With the typical climatic and edaphic conditions prevailing over the coasts, they become ideal places for raising medicinal herbs useful in health care system of rural inhabitants. An enumeration of 26 species worth for cultivation along sea-coast is presented in the paper with their botanical information.*
